

CALIFORNIA STATE FAIR

RABBIT, CAVY & CANINE BOWL CONTEST REGULATIONS

ALL BOWL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE
JUNE 17, 2016

Rabbit Bowl - Sunday, July 10, 2016 12 Noon (Check-in 11am)
Canine Bowl - Saturday, July 16, 2016 12 Noon. (Check-in 11am)
Cavy Bowl - Sunday, July 17, 2016 2 p.m. (Check-in 1pm)

This competition is open to all California 4-H, FFA, Grange, and Independent Youth.

1. Each team must have a minimum of 2 regular members and not more than 4 and one coach. An alternate may be named in case of illness or absence of a regular member. The alternate must be named on the entry form or the alternate is not eligible.
2. Team members are not limited to 4-H members with Rabbit, Cavy, Canine or Poultry projects. Teams comprised of members from multiple counties are acceptable.
3. Credentials for entry to the fairgrounds will be issued for each member not exhibiting in the concurrent show. One additional pass will be issued to one coach per team. One parking pass will be issued to the coach of the team. No additional credentials will be issued.
4. Independent rabbit, cavy and canine teams may participate under an adult supervisor (present at the Fair) if there is no 4-H rabbit, cavy or canine program available in their county.
5. Rabbit, Canine & Cavy Senior Novice Teams: Members must be 14-18 years old by January 1, 2016.
Rabbit, Canine & Cavy Senior Teams: Members must be 14-18 years old by January 1, 2016. Rabbit, Canine & Cavy Junior Novice Teams: Members must be 13 years or younger by January 1, 2016.
Rabbit, Canine & Cavy Junior Teams: Members must be 13 years or younger by January 1, 2016. Juniors may compete on Senior teams in Canine, Rabbit and Cavy Bowls. Seniors may not compete on Junior teams. Each member may compete on only one team. Designation as a Senior or Junior team is determined by the age of team members.
6. All judges' decisions are final. Any team member, coach, or person affiliated with a competing team who interferes with the judge or the competition will be cause for disqualification of that team. No protests shall be filed based on the judge's decision.
7. During the competition, the teams that are waiting to compete will remain in a specified location. Only team members and coaches will be permitted in the waiting area during Rabbit, Cavy and Canine Bowl.
8. All members must be in uniform (either team uniforms or 4-H uniforms). Uniforms shall in all circumstances be in good taste, and appropriate for the occasion.
9. No team will draw more than one "BYE" in the competition.
10. Should two teams from one county draw opposite each other in the first heat, both teams will re-draw. No county shall have two teams compete against each other IN THE FIRST ROUND.
11. The State Fair reserves the right to limit the number of teams competing depending on time available.
12. Certificates will be awarded to the first place teams.
