

BOOK YOUR FARM TOUR NOW!

There are several things we would like you to know before and after you book your tour! Please review the following checklist to ensure you get the most out of your visit to the California State Fair Kaiser Permanente Farm.

- Tours are \$5 per student which covers the cost of materials for the hands-on stations and food at our tasting station. Parents and teachers are free, unless they choose to take part in the activities. Payments must be made in advance or on the day of your tour. Checks are preferred.
- We take up to 60 students per tour time. Before you arrive, please have your students pre-arranged into five groups of 10-12 students per group.
- Book your tour online at castatefair.org/farmtours. You have the option to add a one-hour tour of the California Forest Center at no cost. Please book for 9:30 am- noon if you would like that option.
- Please make it easy for us to identify if any of your students have any severe food allergies. Some teachers have done simple things like have students wear a name tag saying "I'm allergic to nuts!"
- 9:00 am tours must arrive 10-15 minutes early. If you feel that your bus cannot make it to the farm earlier than 9:00 am, please make arrangements when you book your tour. You may email farm@calexpo.com for assistance with booking.
- The California State Fair Kaiser Permanente Farm and The California Forest Center are located behind Building B on CalExpo fairgrounds. Please review the map which can be found at CAStateFair.org/FarmTours.
- The Farm Tours have been designed to give your students the best experience possible. We ask that teachers and parents lend us a hand in making sure students are participating, but that the adults do not interfere with the tour or disrupt the lessons.
- The students will have to think about what they need, please help them prepare for their tour! Look to the right of this list to see items they should have with them.
- Students are often hungry when they arrive to their tour. Please allow adequate time for them to have snacks prior to their tour. We have had tours cut short do to lack of interest and energy because students wanted to eat.
